EXTENSION OF THE COURT CORONAVIRUS MITIGATION PROTOCOLS 4.0 AS SET OUT IN NOTICE # 10

On 5 August, 2020 the Chief Justice issued the Court Coronavirus Mitigation Protocols 4.0 as set out in Notice # 10 (“*the Protocols 4.0*”). Those Protocols cease to have effect at 12:01 a.m. on 24 August, 2020 or such later date as the Chief Justice may direct by Notice or Practice Direction.

It is directed that the Protocols 4.0 are hereby extended and shall cease to have effect at 12:00 midnight on 28 August, 2020 unless further extended by Practice Direction or Notice issued by the Chief Justice.
